SUP Instructor Job Description

Overview

You must truly love working with people and be passionate about SUP, surfing, and the ocean environment! Your typical summer schedule will alternate between public and private SUP lessons, camps, and tours. The SUP Instructor's job includes managing and taking care of equipment, communicating with office staff and clients, and organizing the S.U.P. storage area. This involves cleaning and sweeping it out, restocking with necessary supplies, and cleaning all boards, PFDs, and paddles. You will be required to think ahead, work hard, and be detail oriented in taking care of clients and equipment.

You are expected to pull your weight and do whatever is necessary to set up including: loading, unloading boards and paddles. We seek applicants who show us they will go above and beyond, taking the initiative to do what needs to be done without being asked. All selected candidates will go through our comprehensive, in-house training, but you must be proficient in the sport. You will be spending multiple hours a day in the sun and in the water, observing weather, winds, and tides to ensure clients are staying safe and helping them with paddle technique and maneuvers. We hire applicants who exude enthusiasm for their jobs, and it is expected that you will be a positive role model for our clients and express your enthusiasm in all aspects of the lesson and camp environment including our eco-activities. You will also need to communicate between instructors out in the water to keep your group together and safe.

Explicit details regarding camp and lesson protocols and procedures will be provided to you in your employment packet upon hiring.

- ❖ High School Graduate pursuing a BA or BS in marine biology, environmental science/education, outdoor recreation, related field or equivalent experience.
- ❖ At least 20 years of age
- ❖ Must be in excellent physical condition.
- ❖ Ability to pass a 500 yard open-ocean swim test.
- ❖ Possess knowledge of S.U.P. and surfing fundamentals.
- ❖ Current certifications: ARC Lifeguarding, CPR for the Professional Rescuer and First Aid.
- ❖ Must be able to attend mandatory training (June 6-11, 2017).
- ❖ Willing to work long, exciting hours while maintaining energy and stamina.
- ❖ No conflicting summer commitments including travel, work, or other leave of absence.
- ❖ Reliable and punctual team player.
- ❖ Cell phone and reliable vehicle.

Desired Traits

- ❖ Hold a strong mission statement for life, moral conviction, and a desire to change the world for the better through education and action!
- ❖ Energetic, morning person with a positive attitude.
- ❖ Strong communication, decision making, logistical, and organizational skills.
- ❖ Ability to accept and give constructive criticism.
- ❖ Ability to remain calm, think clearly and act quickly in case of an emergency.
- ❖ Comfortable and effective in public speaking.

Responsibilities and Duties

- ❖ Assist with setup and breakdown every day while maintaining a tight professional image.
- ❖ Supervise and participate in all lessons and camp activities, including providing safety and behavioral management to campers.
- ❖ Prepare transports for upcoming week by cleaning, organizing, and restocking with clean rashguards and necessary supplies.
- ❖ Serve as a positive role model for youth and display maturity, responsibility, flexibility and sound judgment.
- ❖ Put clients' needs before your own. Get to know each client, including their likes and dislikes, and make them feel welcome and accepted.
- ❖ Maintain responsibility & sound judgment while guiding tours, lessons, and camps.
- ❖ Converse with parents and clients before and after lessons and be available to answer questions.
- ❖ Be knowledgeable about and assist in presentation of educational seminars on topics such as rip currents, ocean safety and awareness, our coastal environment, marine life, S.U.P. techniques, and etiquette.
- ❖ Posses open communication with your team and address any issues immediately with your Director.
- ❖ Follow proper Accident Protocol when necessary.
- ❖ Be knowledgeable about Cape Fear Paddleboarding as a company, as well as our diversity of programs.
