The photographer should feel comfortable photographing subjects in a variety of technically challenging lighting conditions within small moments of time in order to provide Surf Camp Inc. with the best product representing the services that are provided. Photos will be taken throughout the day and should fully represent the experience of clients while they enjoy themselves at Surf Camp. At the end of each photo shoot, typically spread out among several days, the photos must be turned into Surf Camp Inc. offices for review and immediate distribution.

Responsibilities

The photographer will use their technical proficiency and artistic eye to document the water escapades and on-land adventures of WB Surf Camp clients. This individual must be very detail oriented and have the ability to photograph persons equally within the assigned groups. The photographer is expected to have, at the minimum, 600 sellable photos by the completion of the overnight groups. All photos are to

be resized to be posted in a gallery on Facebook and DropBox. The photographer should be experienced in Adobe Photo Editing Software/Lightroom and be able to efficiently edit, export, and organize.
